## Second Call for papers

Institute for Information Transmission Problems of the Russian Academy of Sciences (IITP RAS) and Independent University of Moscow with French-Russian Poncelet Lab organize under financial support of Russian Foundation for Fundamental Research and Russian Academy of Sciences a conference to honor the 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Prof. Roland L. Dobrushin (1929-1995). The areas of emphasis of the conference correspond to the main areas of Prof. Dobrushin's academic activities and include

Probability Theory    Mathematical Physics    Statistical Mechanics  
Information Theory    Mathematical Linguistics

**Submission of papers:** Previously unpublished contributions across a broad range of topics in Mathematics and its applications related (but not limited) to the above topics should be submitted to the Program Chairs. Submitted papers should be of sufficient detail to allow review by experts in the field. Final papers should not be more than six pages in length. The proceedings will be available at the conference. Selected papers from the conference will be published in a special issue of Moscow Mathematical Journal devoted to the memory of R.L.Dobrushin.

During the conference the annual International Dobrushin Prize will be awarded.

**Important dates:**

Paper submission deadline June 10, 2009. Notification of acceptance June 20, 2009. Final papers due on June 30, 2009. Deadline for registration June 30, 2009.

The conference will be held in IITP RAS, B.Karetniy 19, in the heart of Moscow, Russia. Registration fee is 100 euro to cover a banquet and other social events.
